

NORTH SHORE, OAHU, HI (Feb. 28, 2005) -- Turtle Bay Resort will serve as the site of the 2005 Callaway Golf PGA Junior Series from July 6 to 8. Celebrating its 10th consecutive year, the series provides affordable and competitive golf for juniors age 13 to 17. This is the first year Turtle Bay Resort is hosting the event.

Other golf clubs hosting the event include McCormick Woods Golf Course, Washington state; Kiawah Island Resort, South Carolina; and Penn State University, Pennsylvania.
